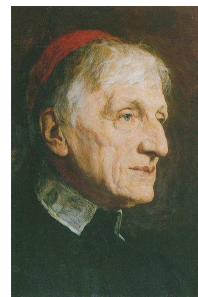

*Dear Brothers and Sisters,*

In a particular way, may each of us consider the special gifts he or she has received, and how we choose to use those gifts to advance the Church's unity, life and mission in the world.
